Community Liaison Chairman's Comment



Redvale Landfill

The current consent process continues with the appeal being held during the week 6th to 9th July. Evidence was presented by both Waste Management (WAM) and the Redvale Environmental Protection Society (REPS). As advised in the last Dairy Flat Newsletter the Community Liaison Committee (CLC) are not directly involved in the appeal process and community interests are being represented by REPS. I appeared before the Commissioners hearing the appeal briefly for cross examination as Chairman of the CLC.

Presentation of evidence by WAM and REPS has been completed and the parties have been directed to discuss certain aspects of the appeal and possible mitigation steps that may be available, before final summing up is presented. That should be completed before the end of July. The Commissioners will then consider the merits of argument from parties before making their judgement. That is likely to take several weeks and it is unlikely to be known before the next CLC meeting.

I am sure both parties, WAM and REPS, will be happy to update any local residents who have questions about the appeal.

WAM are currently setting up a website relating to the Redvale Landfill which will make it easier for local residents to stay in touch with what is going on. There will be an area devoted to the current complaints process which we hope will lead to greater transparency for local residents. The website, I believe, is almost ready for launch and I am hopeful details will appear in WAM's column in the next Newsletter.

The next Community Liaison Committee meeting will take place on Monday 17th August at 7pm. The new cell in Phase 19 is ready for filling, and operations are planning to enter it in Q3 2015. Landfill operations continue to be filling at 100 to 106mRL.

Work is progressing with the new wheelwash and paving of the inner site roads on the landfill side of the new wheelwash location as well as between the old and new wheelwashes. Both systems will be functioning in series, with the old wheelwash being used as a final polish. Foundations and water supply are already in place. A fast fill located in the centre of the site for water carts will be also commissioned as part of these works, The wheelwash equipment is expected to arrive in country, any time soon, after a lengthy unforeseen delay overseas.

The new CAT 836K compactor has arrived and is now operational.

A Geotechnical investigation has been carried out on the acoustic wall close to the landfill gas engine generators. Designs are being finalised. An application for building consent will be made to Council shortly and approvals should be expected in August 2015. Once building consent has been approved, the installation works will proceed.


The consent renewal process has now moved in the appeals stage, after the court proceedings between 10th and 16th July. Closing submissions are being finalised. The court will be determining its decision and notify all parties in due course.

The work in partnership with the Dairy Flat Pony Club on the use of WM land for equestrian activities has been progressing getting the grounds ready for club nights and events throughout the 2015/16 calendar. Regular committee meetings are being held at the Redvale office facilities.

There has also been some timely renewed interest in the use of the Trotting Track and stables, which is encouraging to see. These uses fit in well with our overall plans to provide positive benefit to the surrounding Dairy Flat community.

If you are aware of any sports interest group that may be interested in developing sports facilities in around Dairy Flat, and is looking for a base, we would be pleased meet with them to see if there is a common benefit in line with the recreational use of the site after closure.

Comment from your Local Board Member **John McLean**

In the last issue of this Dairy Flat newsletter, I mentioned Council was seeking your thoughts on its **10 year Budget Plan 2015 – 2025**. This discussion would provide the basis for setting new Council Rates in the new Financial year July 2015 to June 2016 and succeeding years.

Thank you to the folk who responded in writing or online to Auckland's Council funding debate and the issues surrounding fixing its transport problems for example.

This commentary attempts to explain the final outcomes and resolutions set by the governing body Auckland Council since that last newsletter.

The upside for many Dairy flat folk is that your rates Bill has fallen and for others it has been raised marginally compared to significant increases in Auckland's metropolitan area. Those increases in Auckland are shown by chart below.

Like you we have sought for change from within Council, less involvement in our lives , less council, less bureaucracy and the lowering of the dependence on council rates to fund its operations. Just a simple lean machine is what we all want. However those requests are moderated by equally valid arguments of where we are today and the need to act now, to spend the money today because those assets to fund tomorrow will be even more expensive .

For example the cost to improve Auckland's burgeoning transport network, needs to be fixed now. It cannot wait. So in light of this Auckland Council is seeking an additional investment of \$523 million being applied to an accelerated transport programme over the next three years.

This Transport programme will respond to the need for busways, public transport, cycling and walkways amongst other things. In addition, Council will work with central Government on other ways to raise revenue other than by rates. Presently, the introduction of motorway user charges, a relatively new concept for Auckland is being explored..

In the meantime, increased investment will be met by an Interim Transport Levy of \$2.19 per week or \$114 incl. GST p.a. and by Government funding and Council Debt.

Similarly, I believe Council needs to continue to put up other funding alternatives which do not necessarily impact on ratepayers. This thinking must pervade strategy for years to come.

However, the benefits flowing back to Dairy Flat as a result of the 10yr Plan are immediately an improved bus service early in the new year. Funding has also been allocated to completing the Silverdale Park and Ride. This is an excellent outcome for Dairy Flat and those who use this network to get into town each day.

In saying that Rates have been kept minimal in Dairy Flat because we call less upon council for its services and that position must always be protected in rural Rodney.

Dairy Flat Cubs

Term one at Dairy Flat cubs has been very eventful and there was definitely no easing into the year!! We really wanted to get back to basics with the kids which included tying knots and making fire. The cubs mastered a reef, hitch and bowline over several sessions which they were then able to use practically to build and race rafts at the annual Founders day event held in Browns Bay. Our fire night was a favorite for the cubs be very exciting for all involved. With a strong emphasis on safety with demonstrated making fire a magnifying glass and the sun, flint and steel and a battery and steel wool. The cubs all got a hands go at this and made firelighters with cotton wool dipped in vaseline. Our grand finale was the cubs lighting cardboard creations and extinguishing them with their water guns and a fire extinguisher. Following our fire theme we had a night were the cubs made and cooked damper and shared family histories to tick off a requirement for one of the badges. Cubs also achieved their swimming badge this term and we made stilts and learned to work on them. We have had two camps this term the first one at Willow Park primary school which was similar to a mini jamboree which cubs attending for the Maharangi region (300 in total). We had to set up a complete camp site with kitchen, mess, first aid and sleeping tents and activities were run over two days by cub leaders. The second camp was a group camp involving Taioatea venturers, scouts, cubs and keas and Dairy Flat cubs. This group camp was at Bethells Beach and again allowed the children to experience many different activities. We ave finished out term with an emphasis on fishing. In our first session cubs made hand lines, identified local fish and we discussed limits and legal size. This was followed be a filleting demonstrating and we cooked and the cubs got to eat the fish. The last week we fished down at Stillwater wharf with the hand lines and lots of fish were caught including one large legal snapper which a cub pulled in on his hand line!!! He then filleted himself with help and I bet his parents were supervised that he brought home beautiful fresh snapper fillets!! Its truly been a great start to the year and the cubs have learnt many new skills.

Term two was another exciting time at Dairy Flat, we went along to a St Johns cadet session in Silverdale and our kids were taught about the basics and earned themselves a badge. We also did some planting at Shakespear and a weeding at Okura as well as be apart of the international JOTT scouting walk. This was a great way to experience a nature walk in the winter. We did a raid at Orewa Cubs den which was lots of fun getting the kids floured and watered as well as some of the leaders. Mothers Day we made cookies in a jar that was also lots of fun as they got to cook them and eat them with their mums. 
