

USING YOUR BIN SAFELY

It's safety first when it comes to handling bins, and if your bin isn't correctly filled or placed in the right spot, you run the risk of having delays to your waste collection.

To ensure your bin is always collected, follow these simple tips.

DO
Allow enough room for the driver to safely attach lifting chains.

DON'T
Erect scaffolding too close to bins.



DO
Fill the bin only to the top so that it can be covered during transport and travel safely on the roads.

DON'T
Overfill the bin past the top.



DO
Allow for safe, easy access.

DON'T
Move bins under powerlines.



DO
Call us if you need collection or an extra bin.

DON'T
Place overflow waste around the bin.
Use diggers to load or compact bins.



DO
Leave bins where they are placed by the Waste Management driver.

DON'T
Drag or push bins from one location to the next.



DO
Make sure bins have enough space around them to allow for easy access.

DON'T
Place the bin underneath a fixed object such as a canopy or an air conditioning unit.

DON'T
Lift using less than four chains attached.

DO
Lift using all four chains attached.
Safe Working Limit (SWL) 5 tonnes
