63 Richards Rd: Hibiscus Tanks application for concrete tank making operation.

As indicated at the last meeting in February, WMNZ had been approached by Hibiscus Tanks to support their application for a concrete tank business. WMNZ had considered the application and supported it, subject to an agreement from Hibiscus Tanks that they would enter into a covenant and easement, recognising WMNZ landfill activities.

Complaints:

Redvale register attached.

Odour: There was an increased number of complaints received by the landfill particularly during the last 4 to 6 weeks. 18 complaints for odour in April, 6 on 10th April. There were a

number of sources of odour other than the landfill within Dairy Flat eg numerous fires some lasting a day others like the one at Bakers on HSB Rd which had been going for over a week, a new compost centre had opened up on the corner of Kahikatea Flats Rd. We had a waste load from Intergroup which was received on 10 April, which caused 6 complaints. The material had been sent in error. Customer and AC notified. WMNZ will monitor the Road Sweepings loads more frequently.

Action

The high unseasonal extreme rainfall in March (~240mm) and April (~230mm) has initiated an increase in leachate and landfill gas generation. Typically, in last 5 years the rainfall for these months would be 50mm to 100mm. The intense rainfall events have put pressure on the management of surface water, at the discharge locations, with emergency spillways in use on several occasions. These have been well managed. The WMNZ Team remains focused on reducing the number of complaints, and optimising gas collection.

Regulatory Issues:

- WMNZ sought approval for an extension of time for completion of earthworks ahead of the winter. AC granted an extension of time of 1 month. Some soiling and seeding work had been undertaken, as well as creation of additional temporary storage ponds to given the weather delays and the impact of the rainfall on closing out for winter
- AC compliance visit held in February to go through compliance with the new consent conditions process. No non compliances.
- Next AC Site inspection date to be confirmed.

Current issues:

Refuse Truck Vehicle movements:

Aftercare Initiatives:

Questions were raised about WMNZ long term initiatives and what the company position was with regard to community access on the WMNZ land, and what land was covered by the aftercare requirements.

AV explained that the land area covered related to the Landfill Footprint, as defined in the approved drawings. Once the site is closed for landfilling, there will be a continued presence on site and in the Energy Park, for WMNZ to manage processes and activities during the aftercare period: gas, leachate, restoration and closure work would continue, including power generation and export.


The Aftercare period runs for 30 years following closure. Community access for passive /active recreation such as walks, equestrian trails, bike trails were envisaged, as was envisaged at the time of the original consent. However the detail would be drawn up in the future. The nature of Dairy Flat and the needs of the community is likely to change with the development and expansion of Auckland over the next 30 years. Active recreation may mean other sports facilities. Not considered necessary at this stage to define this. Suffice to say, the original idea of community access to the landfill footprint for passive/active recreation remains in place.

Hibiscus Tanks Application for concrete tank fabrication business:

R Gibbs/J Hutchison asked that Head Office should confirm why WMNZ supported the application from Hibiscus Tanks on Richards Rd, an industrial activity in a rural area. It was agreed that Andy would ask head office and report back at next meeting.

Operations Report for Community Liaison Committee Meeting 15th May 2017

- New haul road on the outside edge of PH 19 is complete after trialling rubble and metal rather than lime rock. First indications are good
- New tarmac seal over existing perimeter landfill road of approximately 100 metres with rumble strips to shake mud from tyres
- Cattle grid installed in the out road just before the gates, another system to decrease mud leaving the site
- Concreting surface water drains being installed: 5 week lead time for concrete.
- Filling has finished at the top at RL 106, now through the winter we are filling down low in the old haul road
- Closing out the upper slopes for winter: placing additional intermediate cover soils on the upper slopes.
- Desilting of the sediment ponds finished earlier than usual due to the inconsistent wet weather
- Managed Fill continues to receive material.
- Placed a 3m high bund on the western edge and will be installing odour fence there.




